Parents, I need your help with a very serious safety issue! We communicate often and directly (through video and lunchtime announcements) to our students the necessity of practicing safe and responsible actions on and OFF our campus, particularly while arriving and departing. Yet, some of our students choose to exhibit very reckless and dangerous behaviors by walking in the middle of busy streets, playing “chicken” with traffic on the roads, and even pushing their peers into the street with on-coming traffic in a joking manner.

Through our partnership with parents, school, and the community, we hope to prevent a senseless tragedy. Please take a few minutes to hold a family discussion regarding the devastating impact this type of behavior could have on the life of your student. Concurrently, Horizon’s administrators, deans, counselors, teachers, and staff will continue to stress the importance of safe traffic behavior to our student body. As a community member, if you witness such actions, the Aurora Police Department should be notified at once. Tickets may be issued to anyone choosing to impede traffic while acting recklessly.
